## E-Learning VS Virtual



	Asynchronous (not live/"E-Learning")	Synchronous (live/"Virtual")
Attendance	Complete Google Attendance Form for the day sent by your building administrative assistant.	Attendance is taken by the teacher based on - Grades 6-12: your presence in the Google Meet Grades K-5: completion of work
Student Receives Instruction by	Visiting each Google Classroom for assignments.	Joining your teachers' "LIVE" Google Meets from Google Classroom.
Completion of work	Turn in assignments prior to the next school day.	Turn in assignments as directed by your teacher.
